

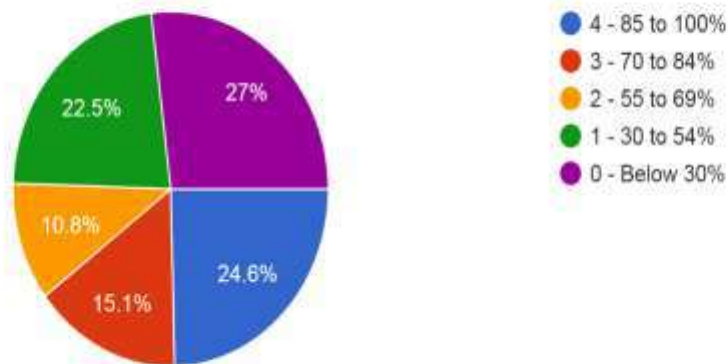

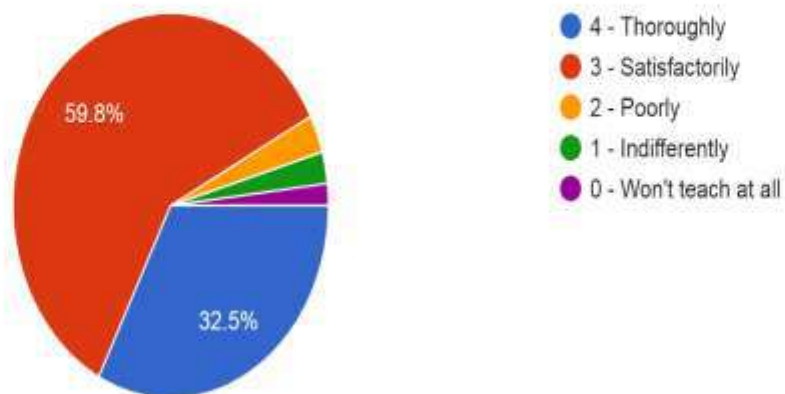
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

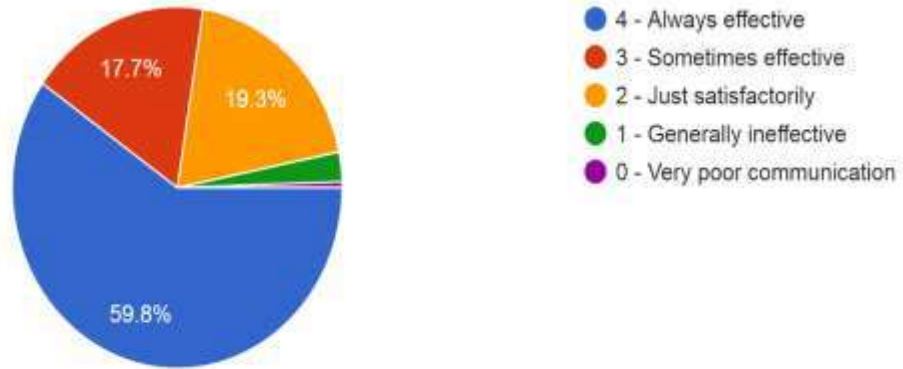
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

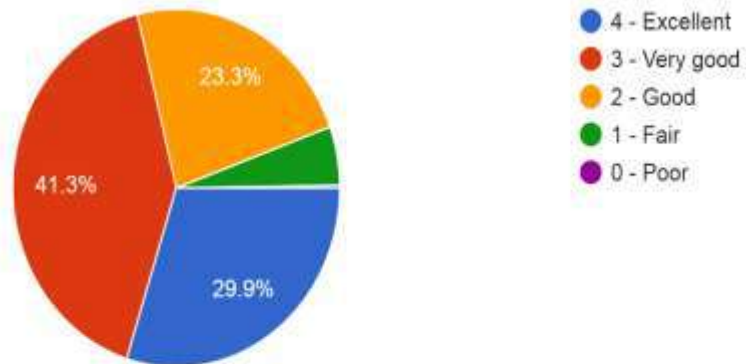
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

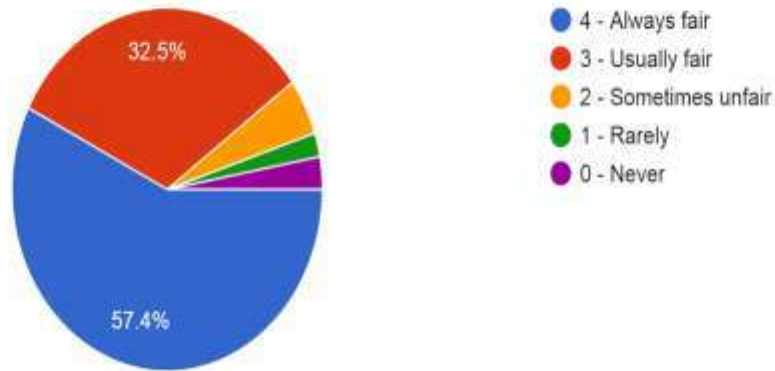
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

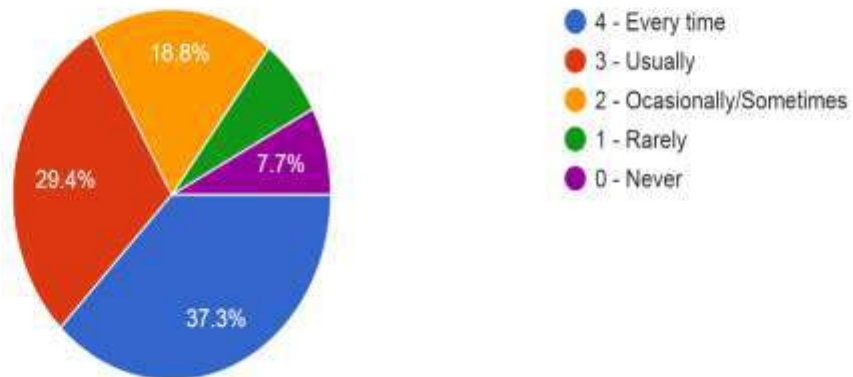
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:

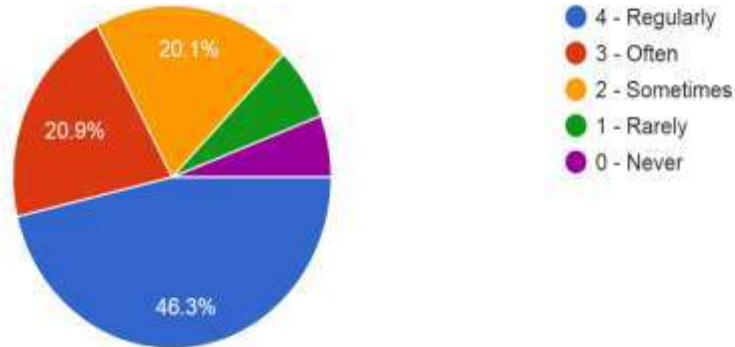
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

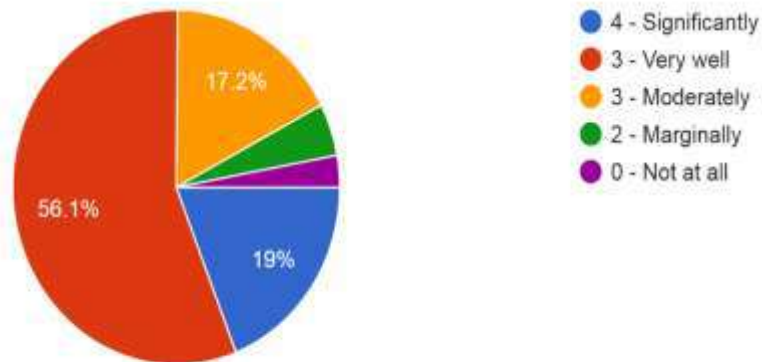

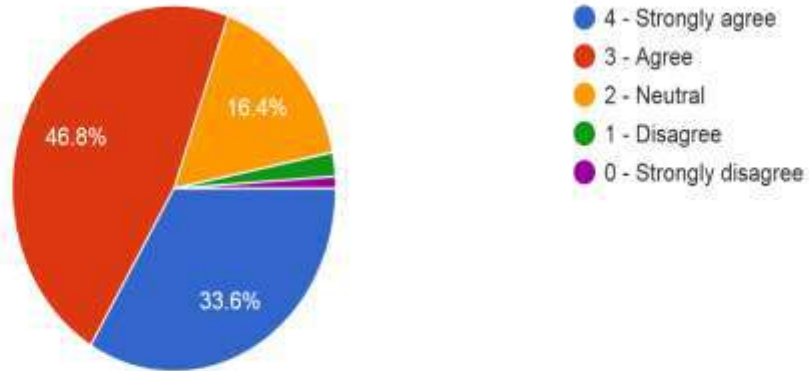
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth:

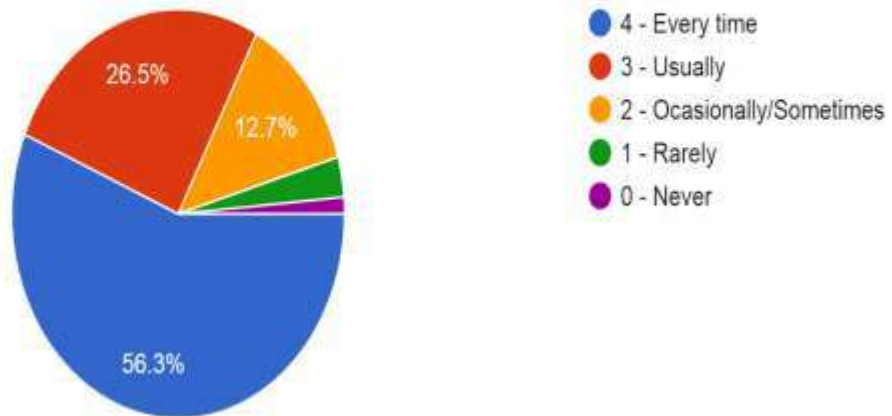

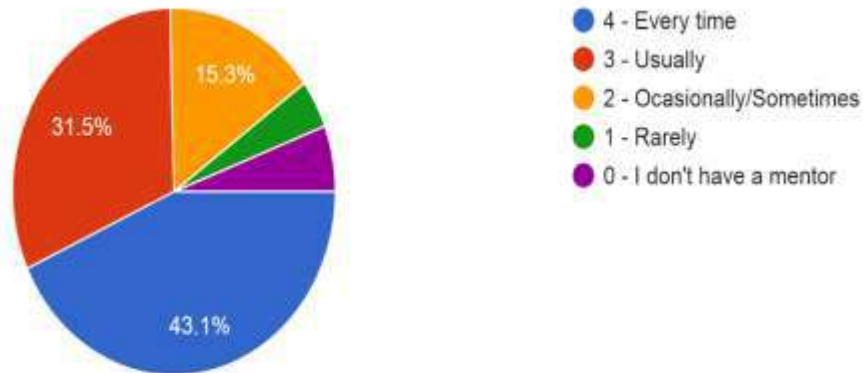
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes:

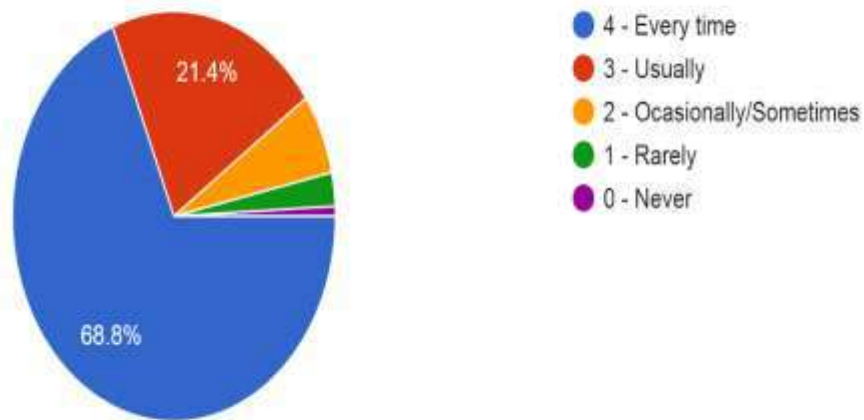

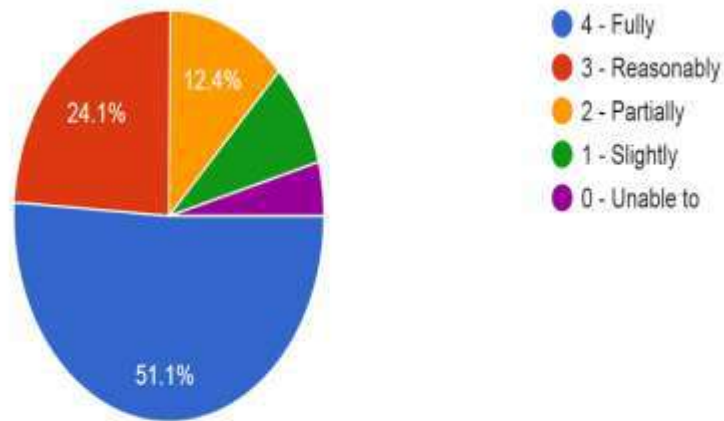
12. The teacher illustrates the concepts through examples and applications:

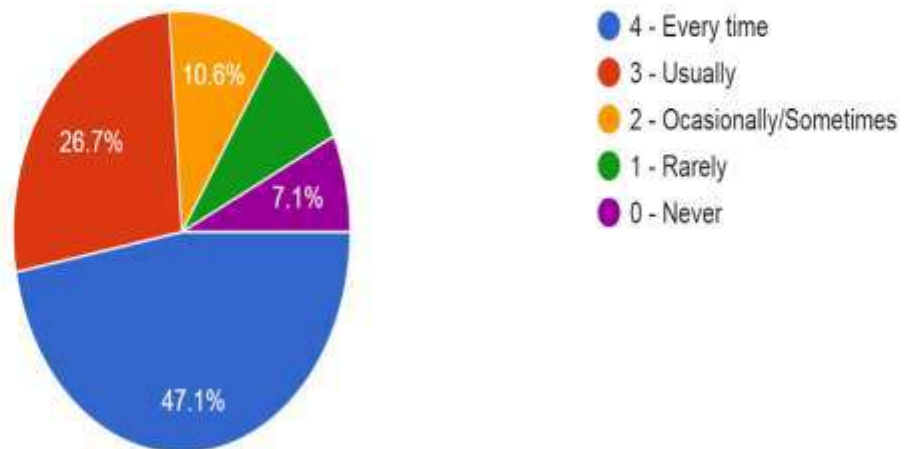

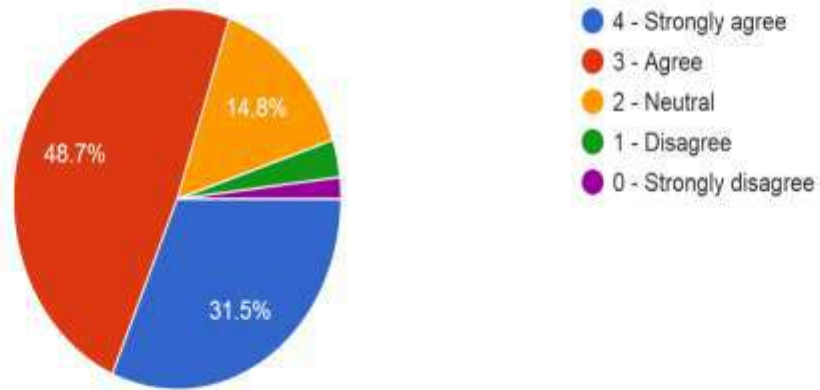

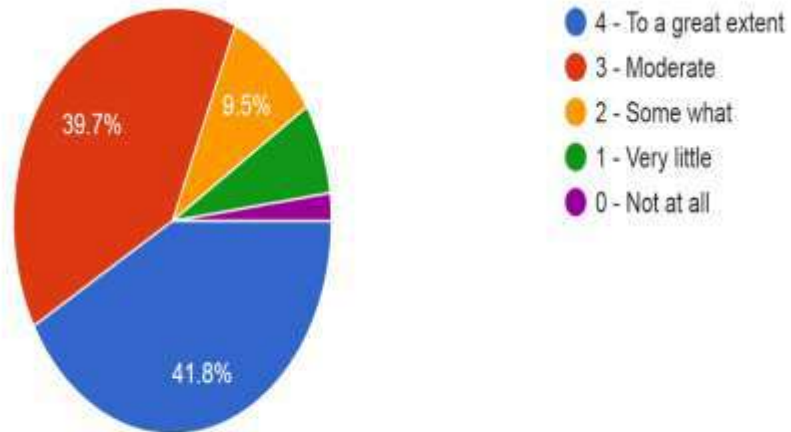

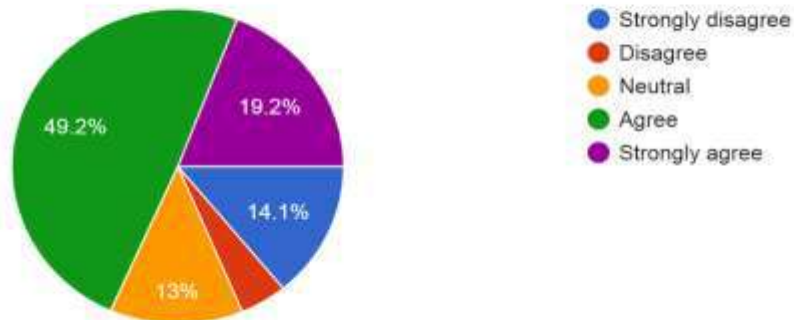

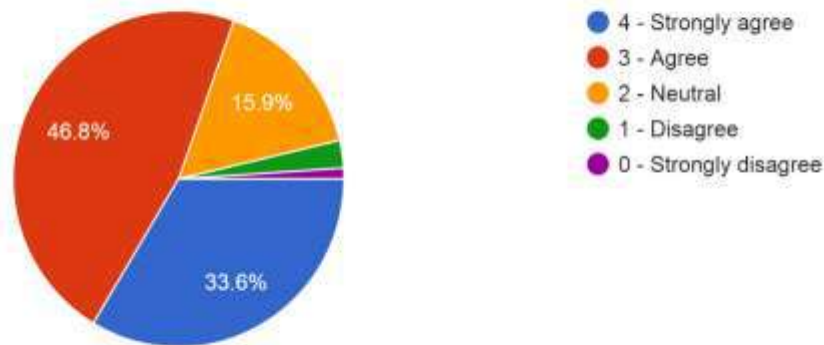
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc while teaching?

Following are the major observations/suggestion given by the students to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in the institution

- iii. Apart from curricular teaching, awareness and education regarding environmental wellbeing must be supported by Add-on courses.

- vi. There should a mechanism to differentiate abilities of students so that adaptive teaching may be practiced.
